Community Bank Inner East is operated by Inner East Community Finance, a local company, owned by local people. We are part of the Bendigo Bank Community Bank network. Twenty-two years ago, we opened our first two branches in Surrey Hills and Canterbury, followed by branch openings in Ashburton and Balwyn. More recently we expanded into Kew, Hawthorn and surrounding areas.

We are much bigger than just a bank, with up to 60% of our profits directed into the local community through our **Community Investment Program** (sponsorship and grants)- \$10 million so far. Our value proposition is simple, local people support us through banking, and we return profits directly back into our community.
